Thursday, June 20, afternoon

16.00-18.00: Arriving at the hotel Skagen and settling in

Friday, June 21

- 9.00-10.00: Visiting the out-door Kinder garten called Maskinisten
- 10.00-10.30: Walking along the small river (20 minutes)
- 10.30- 11-30: Visiting Vågønes barnehage (Kinder garten) Song-play performance
- 11.30: Walking to the city farm Bodin 4H-gård (20 minutes)
- 12.00: Lunch at Bodin 4H-gård
- 13.00: Information about access to nature and the public health program STImuli
- 14:00: Growing food in the Kindergarten. <u>Urban Community supported agriculture</u> University projects presented by Vivi Storsletten
- 15:00: Cafe breaks with waffles and cakes. Guided tour of the city farm
- 16.30: Out walking again, following the small river to the seaside, approx. 3 km
- 17.30 Bodøsjøen friluftsmuseum. Activities like reps crafting, felting wool, whittle/carving, walk on stilts, throwing horseshoes and <u>Viking chess</u> (see video)
- 17.30 20.00: Activities and outdoor Dinner/barbeque at Bodøsjøen friluftsmuseum
- 20.00: Bus leaving for the hotel (approx.. 15 minutes)

Saturday, June 22

- 7.30-8.30: Breakfast at the hotel. Information.
- 9.00 10.00 EFCF AGM- members only
- 10.00-12.00 EFCF general meeting-for everyone
- 12. 00: Lunch at the hotel
- 13.00-13.30: Bus transfer to Ersvika Sami Siida (see photos)
- 13.30- 16.30: Visiting Ersvika Sami Siida where children normally take part in different activities and skills the Sami culture. You will, in an active way, learn about Sami crafts, history and way of living in the present and in the past. You will also experience reindeer- herder explaining about coexistence between indigenous people and nature and how to maintain the traditional way of reindeer -keeping in a

sustainable way, and in harmony with nature. In the program there will also be a taste of Sami food and of course there will be coffee and a bon fire

16.30: Bus leaving for <u>Saltstraumen</u> the world strongest maelstrom, which according to the tidal timetable will be at its most powerful around 17.00 pm. You are free to sit down close to the sea side or walk around the area

18.20: Official photo of the Conference outside Saltstraumen hotel. Be there!

18.30: Bus leaving the natural phenomenon Saltstraumen from Saltstaumen hotel

19.00 -22.00 Dinner from cooking pits served in a big turf hut, accompanied by some Stone Age experiences at historical Tuvsjyen. Sami fairy- tales by Eirin Edvardsen. Bring your swimwear as you will have the possibility to swim in the sea and use the wooden tubs with a nice and warm temperature. Recommended!

22.00: Bus leaving for the hotel (35 km)Sunday, June 23 (Midsummer Night)

Bus transfer to the <u>Kjerringøy Island</u>, 42 km North of Bodø, including a 10 minutes ferry, travelling through a very beautiful landscape

Visiting an <u>organic milk production farm</u>, eating local food for lunch, guiding at the historical trading coastal center, visiting a <u>boat builder</u> and taking a look at outdoor climbing activities for children. Coffee- and tea brakes with homemade pastries. Dinner at the local hotel in the afternoon.
